

SDWWA William Aisenbrey Award

The South Dakota Water and Wastewater Association annually recognizes an operator whose efforts have resulted in an improvement to a water system by the awarding of the William Aisenbrey Award.

1. Eligibility

Any operations specialist at a South Dakota water system and is a current member of the South Dakota Water and Wastewater Association.

2. Basis for Award

The primary basis for this operator award (not facility award) is the best effort, which results in improvement of a water works. The best effort could concern one or more of the following aspects of a water system:

- a. Source(s): pumps, controls, accessories
- b. Transmission lines
- c. Storage
- d. Treatment
- e. Distribution: including high lift pumping, control system, meters
- f. Administration: including records, card files, maps

3. Nominations

Nominations of an operator may be made by anyone. Nominations must be received by SDWWA by July 15 of each year. To nominate an operator, please submit the following: Nominee Name, Address, Water System, Nominator's Name, and a complete description of the effort the resulted in the improvement to a water system.
